 - Review Plan/Implementation/Budget – We are on track with our budget. \$19,000 still remains. One aide is out on medical leave, a new one Gail, has been hired. We will have a 30% budget increase for next year. The upper grades have spent some of the science budget money, about \$2,000 remains. Cheryl explained the idea of developing a science reward room/activity. (Crystals, rockets, bridges, slime, pendulums.) Rene will get a list of ideas.
 - Review/Evaluate Data – Literacy goals were reviewed. Professional development classes for faculty have been held. The data from each grade mid-year testing was reviewed. Most classes are showing strong progress toward our goals.
