- CSIP & School Land Trust Plan (Goals and Expenditures)
 - Review Plan/Implementation/Budget – Spent \$25,000 so far. We are on track now.
 - Science Expenditure Update – Ideas include: microscopes, 3-D Animal models, chemistry sets, magnet kits, bridges, crystal growing kits, earthquake simulation table, snap circuits, stomp rockets, rock and gem set, slime, magformers, bubbles and some general grocery supplies. These will be looked at related to the science curriculum requirements for each grade. We might need a cart to make the supplies portable. A SCC volunteer might explain the activities available to teachers at the first of next year.
 - Review/Evaluate Data – Information will be reviewed with the QH BLT later today. The proficiency scores will be used to set goals for 2017-18.
 - 2017-2018 Goals – No PBIS goal will be required next year, there may be a culture and climate goal instead. We may need to invest in another mobile computer lab for 1st and 2nd grades to share. The Land Trust goals will include Reading, Math & Science. Monies will be used to hire reading and math aides, to purchase technology and to get science materials.

- Digital Citizenship – next week is Media Safety week. There will be different information each day at lunch. A parent meeting will be held on March 9, flyers will be printed.

- Old Business
 - Homework Club/Tutoring – Consistently twelve to fifteen kids participate with five to seven volunteers daily. Volunteers would like more specifics on the needs of each child. Now it is requiring supervision by one of the Intervention aides.
 - Quail Hollow Logo – a variety of drawings will be presented to the logo team on March 24.
 - Teacher of the Year – nominations are being received.
 - School Board Meetings – Does QH need a representative there? Be aware of agenda items.
