3. Quail Hollow fall data
 - Reading
 - Kindergarten first sound fluency – 24.8 +/- about 14
 - First grade: between 49-73% in highest category
 - Second grade: 47-64 in highest category
 - Third grade: 49-71 in highest category, 7-22% in lowest 2 categories
 - Fourth grade: Dibels or adaptive test, depending on proficiency, different distribution of scores
 - Fifth grade: Much higher scores on adaptive test (could be increased familiarity, could be different cohort)
 - Math
 - Scores increase by each year, benchmark increases by each year
 - SAGE
 - Quail Hollow is higher than state, higher than district
 - Mary Jo tracks the progress of students receiving help from SCC-funded aides.
