- The school Land Trust Plan & CSIP goals were reviewed. Quail Hollow's goal is to have students reading with 85% meeting benchmark on the CBM in spring of 2016. The math goal is 93% at benchmark on the MComp in spring. The PBIS goal is 4:1 positive to corrective responses from teachers.
- The Quail Hollow data of our school grade of "B" was presented. It was noted that with many high-achieving students, showing significant growth is more challenging. The PACE report was also introduced.
- Quail Hollow has 507 students. Our enrollment teacher student ratio is slightly below the standard of K-3 having 23 students, and 4-5 having 26 students.
