 - External Communication
 - i. Newsletter – Monthly Article- Parents will be encouraged to support Senate Bill 109 which will increase the Land Trust money distributed to schools from 2.5% to 4%.

3. LAND Trust Email from Paula Plant – Discussion of the proposed Senate and House Bills

4. CSIP & School Land Trust Plan (Goals and Expenditures)- Goal 85% based on CBM, math 93%, and PBIS ratio of 4:1 positive responses.
 - Review CBM results- the benchmark raises each term. Math is showing growth in most grade levels. Language Arts is generally maintaining grade level goals. As a school our whole groups are doing well. The children below benchmark need Skills Based Instruction daily. The classroom teacher needs to see the Tier2/3 children routinely. Teachers need time to plan for the small group instruction. It is also important to meet the needs of the accelerated students through enrichment groups.
 - Discuss goals for upcoming year – Similar goals for next year with continued focus on small groups. Next year, K, 1, and 2 will use similar assessments to this year. 3rd grade will add DAZE comprehension component. Grades 4 and 5 will add the SRI to assess reading comprehension. In math both the computation test and the concepts & applications tests will

be administered. The possibility of science lab materials and an extra science lab instructor will be considered, AND/OR this will be incorporated in the STEM program.

- Possible CSIP goals will pull from some of the new assessments. The language arts goal will stay at 85%, the math goal will be 93% meeting benchmark, though using the MCAP some scores may be different.
- The SCC may appoint a person to fill the vacancy created by Kelly Putzke who received a morning work assignment and is unable to attend. Rene will contact Melinda Rosevere. Cheryl will confirm Kelly's departure.
